### Comments

Majority chose the northern option for the start. Southern option much less popular. Probably made sense as gave better access to the rich points area in the forest. Some also probably put off by the height and relative isolation of the 90 point hill. (in fact only 2m higher than the 'airstrip' hill.

The balance of points between the two halves was very similar but the ability to score big points early by going north probably counted for a lot. The location of one further high value control, reasonably close in, in the southern area might have induced more uncertainty and improved the course.
